Community Stats

- Humber River Health's Community is over 850,000 people
- Just 12% of our community are assigned to a Family Doctor
- Over 5000 people have been on a waiting list for a Family Doctor in our community

Schulich FMTU

- May 2024 is one year since the clinic opened
- Over 1900 patients have rostered to our clinic since it opened (as of March 30, 2024)
- We began the program with 4 residents who are mentored by Family Physician leads
- In July we will be welcoming 7 more residents (for a total of 11) and with that grow the capacity to support more patients.

Funding

- Schulich FMTU is 100% donor funded with a \$10,000,000 goal

To date we have raised:

- \$1,000,000 initial commitment from the Saight Family Foundation
- \$5,000,000 commitment from the Schulich Family Foundation
- \$67,000+ raised through the 2023/2024 Ramadan Campaign.
